8B. <u>Recommendation to Approve Courtyard Stair Replacement</u>

Recommend the Luzerne County Community College Board of Trustees approve the award of the Courtyard Stair Replacement project bd to the lowest responsible bidder: Panzitta Enterprises, Inc. in the amount of \$318,600. In addition, the architect and engineering fees payable to hemmler + camayd architects, in line with the agreement in place (7.99% for this project cost) in the

amount of \$25,456.14 will be incurred. An 8% contingency fee - \$25,488 for the contractor and \$2,036.49 for related architect and engineering services – could be incurred, for a total project cost of \$371,580.63.

The 8% contingency is not a definite expenditure; however, available if necessary. If it is not utilized as part of the project, the funds will be returned to the available funds for other projects.

8C. <u>Recommendation to Approve RFP for Agencies Providing Remote Captioning Services for</u> the Deaf and Hard of Hearing.

Recommend the Luzerne County Community College Board of Trustees approve the proposal to Classroom Captioning at the following rate of \$75.00 an hour with a 1-hour minimum time limit.
