

## **LCCC RESTART PROGRAM**

LCCC is launching a new initiative to help students who had to interrupt their studies due to college debt. The Restart Program is designed to help students get back to college and finish their degree, while also assisting with meeting obligations of institutional debt. According to College records, the program has the potential to provide close to 6,000 students in NEPA with a new opportunity to return to college and complete their degree. The program identifies former students who have unpaid tuition and fees with LCCC and allows them to reenroll. Students must apply for acceptance into the program. Accepted students who successfully meet the program's requirements would be eligible to have 25% of their unpaid tuition and fees relieved after the completion of each successful semester. The program is open to individuals who attended LCCC between August 2012 and August 2022 and have unpaid tuition and fees of \$200 or higher, and who are not currently enrolled at the College. Students who enroll in the program are required to attend financial literacy workshops, meet with an academic advisor and/or retention specialist, complete a counseling and planning session with the Career Services Office, attend a satisfactory academic progress workshop, and complete a FAFSA for the current year. The program will begin with the Summer 2023 semester.
