Application Instructions

1. Application

Complete the Application for admission and return it to the Office of Admission, or visit www.luzerne.edu to apply online.

2. Transcripts

Submit your official high school transcripts or GED to the Office of Admissions. Transfer applicants are required to submit official transcripts from all other colleges/universities to the Registrar's Office in order to have previously and continuously earned college credits evaluated.

3. Placement Testing

Placement testing is required for all first time students prior to enrollment. The placement test is a computerized test designed to assist both students and LCCC academic advisors in determining proper course level placement to optimize student success. Transfer students who have successfully completed college courses at another post-secondary institution and submit official transcripts to the Registrar's Office may be exempt from the placement test. Applicants with SAT scores of 500 Verbal and 450 Math or ACT scores with 20 English and 21 Math are exempt from the placement test.

Financial Aid

Luzerne County Community College participates in all Federal and State financial aid programs. Health Sciences Admission

All Health Sciences programs have separate admission requirements. Admission to the college and meeting the minimum Health Sciences admission requirements does not guarantee admission to specific Health Sciences programs. Selective admission is required due to the limited number of clinical facilities available and program accreditation standards. All Health Sciences applicants will be placed in the General Studies curriculum pending acceptance into a Health Sciences program. Health Sciences applicants must complete and submit all Health Sciences admission requirements by the application deadline for each program. The Department of Health Sciences requires all students admitted to a Health Sciences program receive clearances on clinical background checks before final acceptance into a Health Science program. *The application deadline is December 1 for Health Sciences Programs (Dental Hygiene, Medical Assisting, Nursing, LPN-RN, Respiratory Therapy, Surgical Technology, and EMS/Paramedic).* For more information Health Sciences Programs, please visit www.luzerne.edu/admissions/starthinfo.jsp
