### About this Agreement:

Luzerne County Community College ("Luzerne") and Misericordia University ("Misericordia") have agreed to a correlation of curricula for students in the Associate in Applied Science Early Childhood Education, at Luzerne and desire to complete the Bachelor of Science Early Childhood Education at Misericordia in either the Prek-4 Certification or Prek-4/Special Education Dual Certification program. Subject to the terms of this Agreement a student who satisfactorily completes the requirements of and obtains the AAS degree at Luzerne with a 3.0 grade point average and has passed, or qualifies to pass, the basic skills testing requirement will be granted admission to Misericordia and will have earned credits accepted in transfer based on the agreement equivalency.

The following terms and conditions shall apply:

- 1) The student must declare intent to enroll at Misericordia prior to the completion of their 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of study at Luzerne (between 30 and 45 credits earned).
- 2) A minimum of 120 credits are required for an undergraduate degree at Misericordia.
- 3) Transfer students must earn a minimum of 60 credits at Misericordia.
- 4) Students must maintain an overall 3.0 GPA in order to progress in the program as a teacher candidate.
- 5) This Agreement is a guide only. Misericordia cannot guarantee the needed courses will be offered in a given semester.
- 6) Misericordia estimates a student will be able to earn the BS in two (2) years (minimum of four semesters).
- 7) The student must meet all requirements of the Program-to-Program Agreement noted above.
- 8) The student shall choose the recommended core courses and course sequence as shown in Attachments A and B (ECE and ECE/SpEd Curriculum Guide).
- 9) Following formal acceptance into this Program-to-Program Agreement, the student will receive from Misericordia University a \$2000.00 scholarship which will be used to offset the cost of enrolling at Misericordia.
- 10) Following formal acceptance into this Program-to-Program Agreement, the student will be entitled to take up to 9 credits at Misericordia that can reverse transfer to Luzerne. It is

- suggested that students use these credits to take MAT 115 Basic Statistics, SOC 101 Comparative Sociology and ENG 247, 248, 245 or 246 on Misericordia Curriculum Guide.
- 11) The student must not attend another institution of higher education between Luzerne graduation and Misericordia enrollment.

If the above terms and conditions are not met, credit transfer determination will be completed by Misericordia on an individual basis. A course-to-course evaluation will also be completed for all students transferring without an earned associate degree.

The Agreement may be terminated by either Luzerne or Misericordia at any time via written notification to the other institution. The termination will go into effect thirty (30) days after receipt of notice to terminate and will not apply to any students who have already begun the Associate Degree program at Luzerne or the Bachelor Degree program at Misericordia.
